# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the State Reformatory for Men.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, for 2 the state reformatory for men for the fiscal year July first, 3 nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, to June thirtieth, nine-4 teen hundred and thirty, inclusive, and for the fiscal year 5 July first, nineteen hundred thirty, to June thirtieth, nine-6 teen hundred and thirty-one, inclusive, the sum of sixty-six 7 thousand two hundred dollars for the purposes hereinafter 8 specified, namely:

Personal services for salaries and wages of officers

and employers,

Maintenance for food supplies, wearing apparel, all articles of personal clothing and materials for their fabrication and repair, \$30,000.00
Repairs and equipment, all materials, supplies and labor required for repairs and upkeep of grounds, buildings and attached fixtures, \$15,000.00
Provided, that the governor and council, may, by order, 2 upon recommendation of the trustees of said institution, 3 authorize the use of unexpended balances of any of the 4 above appropriations to meet deficiencies in other appropriations for the same institution.
