IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Authorize the Erection of a Dam Across the East Branch of Spruce Creek, Sometimes Called Barter's Creek, in the Town of Kittery.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Construction and maintenance authorized: Lucius E. D.

- 2 Seeger and other owners of land on the east branch of
- 3 Spruce Creek, sometimes known as Barter's Creek, in the
- 4 town of Kittery, their associates, heirs and assigns, of the
- 5 town of Kittery, be and hereby are authorized to erect and
- 6 maintain a dam across said east branch of Spruce Creek or
- 7 Barter's Creek at or near Crockett's Neck, so-called, in said
- 8 town of Kittery.
