STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Establish the Legal Length Limit of Square-Tailed
Trout and Land-Locked Salmon in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter one hundred and seventy-nine of
2 the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, is
3 hereby amended by striking out all of said section and by
4 substituting therefor the following section:

‘Section 1. *Taking of square-tailed trout less than ten*
2 *inches prohibited in Cumberland county.* It shall be unlaw-
3 ful for any person at any time to take or catch and kill any
4 square-tailed trout less than ten inches in length, or any
5 land-locked salmon less than twelve inches in length, in any

6 lake or pond situated wholly or partly in the county of
7 Cumberland.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in posses-
2 sion at any time any square-tailed trout less than ten inches
3 in length, or any land-locked salmon less than twelve inches
4 in length, taken in any lake or pond situated wholly or part-
5 ly in said Cumberland county.'
