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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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RESOLVE, to Provide for a Memorial to Harold T. Andrews  
the First Maine Man to Lose his Life in the World War.

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Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the  
2 sum of three thousand dollars for the purpose of erecting  
3 in the State House some suitable memorial to the late  
4 Harold T. Andrews of Portland, the first Maine man to  
5 lose his life in the American Expeditionary Forces in the  
6 World War. The governor is hereby authorized and di-  
7 rected to appoint a commission of three persons to serve  
8 without pay to make all necessary contracts and arrange-  
9 ments for the erection of the memorial. All the necessary

10 expenses of the commission appointed under the provisions  
11 of this resolve incident to the carrying out of the provisions  
12 of this resolve shall be paid from the sum hereby appro-  
13 priated.
