RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Danforth, for Reimbursement.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to

- 2 be paid to the town of Danforth, for reimbursement for sup-
- 3 plies furnished and funeral expenses incurred in the sick-
- 4 ness and death of Joseph McLaughlin, the sum of six hun-
- 5 dred forty-four dollars and forty-three cents.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Danforth paid this amount of money to the town of Skowhegan for his pauper supplies and burial expenses. After payment it was found that he had no residence in Danforth. Information was withheld presumably for fear of deportation.
