STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Kate D. Talbot
of Machias.

Resolved: That a pension of eight dollars per month be,
2 and hereby is, granted to Kate D. Talbot, of Machias, to be
3 paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and
4 their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nine-
5 teen hundred and twenty-nine and continue until otherwise
6 provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Kate D. Talbot, 45 years old, is the daughter of Frederick O. Talbot, who served in Company K, First Maine Heavy Artillery, during the Civil War. She is mentally incompetent. Edward E. Talbot, of Machias, is her guardian.
