STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Change the Time of Holding One of the Terms of the Superior Court for the County of Androscoggin.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section six of chapter two hundred sixty of the public

- 2 laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, as amended by
- 3 chapter one hundred seventy-eight of the public laws of
- 4 nineteen hundred and nineteen, is hereby further amended
- 5 by striking out the word "April" in the second line of said
- 6 section and inserting in place thereof the word 'May,' so
- 7 that said section as amended shall read as follows:
- 'Sect. 6. Said court shall be held for civil and criminal 2 business on the first Tuesdays of February, May, June,

3 October and December, provided that the grand jury shall 4 attend only at the October, February and June terms, unless 5 specially summoned by order of the court. All recogni-6 zances for appearance to abide action by the grand jury 7 shall be for appearance at the term at which the next regu-8 lar session of the grand jury is held, but appeals in criminal 9 as well as civil matters and removals shall be to the next 10 regular term.'
