STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Six of Chapter One of the Revised Statutes Relating to Rules of Construction.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section six of chapter one of the revised statutes is hereby

- 2 amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to
- 3 be numbered XXX and to read as follows:

'XXX. For the purpose of filling a public office, the terms

- 2 "vacant" and "vacancy" include the case where the person
- 3 elected or appointed to such office is ineligible, dies, or be-
- 4 comes incapacitated before qualifying for the same as re-
- 5 quired by law.'
