STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the York County Law Library.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section eight of chapter thirteen of the revised statutes,
2 as amended by chapter thirty of the public laws of nineteen
3 hundred and twenty-one, is hereby further amended by
4 striking out the words "county of Lincoln" in the second
5 line and inserting in place thereof the words 'counties of
6 York and Lincoln' and by inserting the words 'The treas7 urer of the county of York shall annually pay to the treas8 urer of the law library association of his county the sum of
9 seven hundred and fifty dollars' after the word "dollars" in 10 the seventh line, so that said section as amended shall read 11 as follows:

'Sect. 8. The treasurer of each county, except the counties 2 of York and Lincoln, shall annually pay to the treasurer 3 of the law library association of his county, for the uses and 4 benefits of the county law library, the sum of five hundred 5 dollars. The treasurer of the county of Lincoln shall annu-6 ally pay to the treasurer of the law library association of 7 his county, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars. The 8 treasurer of the county of York shall annually pay to the 9 treasurer of the law library association of his county the 10 sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars. The treasurer of II Aroostook county shall pay annually to the law library asso-12 ciation of said county the sum of five hundred dollars, in 13 addition to the five hundred dollars above mentioned, and 14 at least five hundred dollars shall be expended annually by 15 the library association of said county for books for the 16 library at the court house at Caribou in said county. The 17 treasurer of each county shall also pay to the treasurer of 18 the law library association of his county all money received 19 from persons admitted as attorneys in the supreme judicial 20 court upon motion, without a certificate from the board of 21 examiners of applicants for admission to the bar.'
