STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Prohibit Trapping of Fur-bearing Animals Within the County of Lincoln for a Period of Four Years.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whoever within a period of four years from the time this

- 2 act becomes effective shall set any trap within the county
- 3 of Lincoln for the purpose of catching any fur-bearing
- 4 animal, or whoever has in his possession during that period
- 5 any fur-bearing animal or parts thereof taken in a trap in
- 6 said county of Lincoln, shall pay a fine of fifty dollars and
- 7 costs for each offense, and in addition thereto three dollars
- 8 for each fur-bearing animal trapped, caught or had in pos-
- 9 session in violation hereof.
