STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Two of Chapter One Hundred of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-five Relating to the Transportation or Board of Children in Places of Temporary Residences, Provided for; Procedure to Obtain; Payment of, How Made.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of chapter one hundred of the public laws of
2 nineteen hundred and twenty-five is hereby amended by
3 striking out in line twelve after the words "from the" the
4 word "equalization" and substituting therefor the words
5 'state school,' and by striking out in line thirteen after the
6 word "distribution" the words "state school" and substitut-

7 ing therefor the word 'such'; so that the section as amended
8 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. *Transportation or Board of Children in Places
2 of Temporary Residences, Provided for; Procedure to Ob-
3 tain; Payment of, How Made.* Where the distance from
4 the place of temporary residence to the school is more than
5 two miles and transportation is deemed advisable by the
6 superintending school committee, the superintendent of
7 schools shall report the same to the state commissioner of
8 education with such other information as may be required
9 and if so directed by the state commissioner of education
10 shall procure transportation for such child or children or,
11 if transportation is inadvisable, board in lieu thereof, pro-
12 vided that when there shall be reported to the commissioner
13 of education in connection with the annual report a bill of
14 expenses incurred in connection with such transportation
15 or board, the state commissioner of education is hereby
16 authorized to reimburse such towns and plantations for
17 such expenses, the same to be paid from the state school
18 fund and at the time of the distribution of such fund.'
