STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section One Hundred Seventy-five of Chapter Sixteen of the Revised Statutes of Nineteen Hundred Sixteen Relating to Rules and Regulations Governing the Issuance of Teachers' Pensions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That section one hundred seventy-five of chapter sixteen
2 of the revised statutes be and hereby is amended by adding
3 at the close of the section the following: 'Provided further
4 that in case of total disability on the part of the teacher,
5 who has reached the age of fifty, and such teacher has no
6 other means of support, the state commissioner of educa-
7 tion is hereby authorized after due investigation to issue to

8 such teacher a pension, the amount of which shall be de-
9 termined by the length of service as set forth in this act,
10 said teacher having complied with the conditions of the law
11 relative to length of experience and to service within the
12 state'; so that the section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 175. The state superintendent of public schools
2 shall formulate rules and regulations for carrying into ef-
3 fect the provisions of the six preceding sections. Provided
4 further that in case of total disability on the part of the
5 teacher, who has reached the age of fifty, and such teacher
6 has no other means of support, the state commissioner of
7 education is hereby authorized after due investigation to
8 issue to such teacher a pension, the amount of which shall
9 be determined by the length of service as set forth in this
10 act, said teacher having complied with the conditions of the
11 law relative to length of experience and to service within
12 the state.'
