IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Six of Chapter Thirty-three of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Twenty-seven, Relating to the Sale and Exchange of Town Forests and the Location of Public Ways Therein.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section six of chapter thirty-three of the public laws of 2 nineteen hundred twenty-seven is hereby amended by strik-
3 ing out the whole of said section and by substituting in
4 place thereof the following:

'Sect. 6. *Lands acquired may be sold or exchanged; excep-*
2 *tion; ways may be located.* Whenever it shall be deemed
3 of advantage to such city or town to sell or exchange such

4 forest lands or any part thereof, or to locate thereon any
5 public highway or foot-path, such city, by vote of its city
6 council, and such town by vote of its inhabitants at town
7 meeting, after due notice given, may authorize such sale
8 or exchange or the location of such way or path, and may
9 execute any conveyances or take any other steps necessary
10 to carry the same into effect. Provided, however, that the
11 power of sale or exchange herein granted shall not apply
12 to lands held in trust by such city or town unless in accord-
13 ance with the terms of such trust.'
