STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Bonds of Licensed Detectives.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Every licensed detective, before receiving his commission,
2 shall file with the secretary of state for the approval of the
3 governor and council a bond in the amount required by
4 statute.
