STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Qualification of Public Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All public officers appointed by the governor and council
2 shall, within thirty days after being commissioned, qualify
3 to perform the duties of their office and shall file in the
4 office of the secretary of state a certificate of such qualifica-
5 tion. Any such officer who fails to qualify and file a cer-
6 tificate of qualification in the office of the secretary of
7 state within thirty days, as above provided, shall be deemed
8 to have forfeited his appointment and the office may be
9 declared vacant by the governor and council and a new
10 appointment made.
