STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Thirty-one of Chapter One Hundred and Seventeen of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Salaries of Public Officers, and the Compensation of Members of the Government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-one of chapter one hundred and seventeen
2 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out
3 said section in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the
4 following:

'Sect. 31. The annual salary of each member of the 2 public utilities commission shall be six thousand dollars, 3 and the salary of subordinate officials and employees of said

- 4 commission shall be left to the discretion of the public
- 5 utilities commission, subject to approval of the governor and
- 6 council; the commissioners and all employees shall receive
- 7 actual expenses when traveling on official business.'
