HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Thirty-four of Chapter Forty-nine
of the Revised Statutes Relative to the Weekly Payment of
Wages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-four of chapter forty-nine of the revised
2 statutes relative to the weekly payment of wages is hereby
3 amended by striking out the words "violates the provisions
4 of this section" in the last sentence of said section and by
5 inserting in place thereof the words, "by such special con-
6 tract or other means exempts himself or itself from the
7 provisions of this section, so that said last sentence of said
8 section as amended shall read as follows:

‘Whoever by such special contract or other means exempts
2 himself or itself from the provisions of this section shall be
3 punished by a fine of not less than ten, nor more than fifty
4 dollars.’
