IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Change the Name of Birch Island in Sebago Lake to Grey Boulder Island.

Resolved: That the name of Birch Island, so-called, in 2 Sebago lake, in the town of Casco, county of Cumberland, 3 be changed to Grey Boulder Island, by which name it shall 4 hereafter be known and called.
