STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Adjutant General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-six of chapter one hundred seventeen of
2 the revised statutes as amended by chapter seventy-nine of
3 the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one is hereby
4 further amended by striking out the words "twenty-five hun-
5 dred" in the second line thereof and inserting in lieu there-
6 of 'four thousand,' so that said section as amended will read
7 as follows:

'Sect. 26. *Salary increased.* The adjutant general shall
2 receive an annual salary of four thousand dollars; he shall
3 receive no other fee, emolument or perquisite.'
