STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of Register of Deeds for Knox County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen
2 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out in the eighth paragraph thereof
4 after the words "register of deeds" the words "seven hun5 dred and eighty dollars" and inserting in place thereof the
6 words 'nine hundred and thirty-six dollars,' so that said
7 paragraph, as amended, in so far as it relates to clerk hire

8 in the office of the register of deeds of Knox county, shall 9 read as follows: 'for clerks in the office of the register of 10 deeds, nine hundred and thirty-six dollars.'
