STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Henry W. Boynton of Jefferson.

Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be 2 and hereby is, granted to Henry W. Boynton of Jefferson, 3 to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers 4 and their dependents. Said pension shall begin on July 5 first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine and continue until 6 otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Henry W. Boynton is the son of Abial B. Boynton who served in Company B, First Maine Cavalry during the Civil War. His term of service was from September 15, 1864 to May 28, 1865. Mr. Boynton is incapacitated from sickness and accidents and cannot earn enough to support himself and wife. His wife is badly crippled; she has lost one limb and the other is disabled.
