# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Rena Cooley.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of three hundred dollars for the year ending June 3 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty, and the sum of three 4 hundred dollars for the year ending June thirtieth, nine-5 teen hundred and thirty-one, to be paid in quarterly pay-6 ments of seventy-five dollars each, to Rena Cooley of Au-7 gusta, for and in behalf of herself and her minor children, 8 Violet and Evely, under the supervision of the governor 9 and council.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The husband of Rena Cooley was in the employ of the state at the state hospital at Augusta; he was killed by one of the patients on the twenty-second day of February, 1913; both of her children mentioned are minors; through her own labor and the pension from the state she is able to support herself and children.
