STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for
Perley A. Haskell of Augusta.

Resolved: That a pension of eighteen dollars per month
2 be, and hereby is, granted to Perley A. Haskell, of Au-
3 gusta, to be paid quarterly from the fund for soldiers and
4 sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July
5 first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and continue until
6 otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu
7 of the state pension which he is now receiving.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This man was granted a state pension of fifteen dollars per month by chapter 117 of the resolves of 1917. His name appears as Perlie A. Haskell. He is sixty-two years of age. He served in the Army from 1885 until 1888. He was originally in the Ordnance Department, and was transferred to the Hospital Corp. His condition is such that he must have additional aid and respectfully asks for this increase in his state pension.
