## STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to State Aid to Academies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section one hundred three of chapter sixteen of the re2 vised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the
3 third line thereof after the word "exceeding" the word
4 "two" and inserting in place thereof the word 'three' and
5 by striking out in the ninth line thereof after the word
6 "exceed" the word "two" and inserting in place thereof the
7 word 'three,' so that said section as amended shall read as
8 follows:

'Sect. 103. No academy shall receive state aid under sec-

2 tion ninety-eight if said academy has an annual income 3 from invested funds exceeding three thousand dollars; and 4 no academy shall receive state aid to exceed five hundred 5 dollars in any given year provided the said academy has 6 an annual income from invested funds exceeding one thou-7 sand dollars; provided, however, that any academy with a 8 larger average attendance than two hundred shall receive 9 such aid not to exceed one thousand dollars if its annual in-10 come from invested funds, after deducting interest paid on 11 its indebtedness, does not exceed three thousand dollars.'
