# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Establish the Territorial Limits of the South Paris Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Preamble. Whereas, the territorial limits of the South Paris Village Corporation as described in the private and special laws of eighteen hundred sixty-six, chapter seventy-five, and acts amendatory thereto are indefinite and

Whereas, the inhabitants of said South Paris Village Corporation desire to have the territorial limits definitely established.

Section 1. The municipal officers of South Paris Village 2 Corporation are hereby authorized to establish the territo include in said limits all the property within the following mentioned bounds: beginning at a point on the Norway
town line forty rods northerly from the most northerly house
in Oxford Park, so-called; thence easterly to Swift's Crossing on High street; thence easterly to the intersection of
the Paris Hill road and Hill street; thence southeasterly
to to the intersection of the Buckfield road and Brett Hill
road; thence southerly to a point on the East Oxford road
sixty rods southerly from the intersection of the Hebron
road and East Oxford road; thence westerly to the Norway town line, at a point just south of the Oxford County
fair grounds; thence northerly on Norway town line to
point of beginning, together with the inhabitants thereon.

Sect. 2. Local referendum provided for. This act shall 2 not become operative until it is ratified by a majority vote 3 of the legal voters of South Paris Village Corporation at 4 an annual or special meeting of said corporation called by 5 a warrant containing an article for the purpose.
