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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT to Amend Section Thirteen of Chapter Twenty-three  
of the Revised Statutes Requiring Motor Boats to Be  
Equipped with Suitable Mufflers.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirteen of chapter twenty-three of the revised  
2 statutes is hereby amended by adding to the end of said  
3 section the following: 'In addition to other remedies pro-  
4 vided by statutes, municipal officers, on complaint, shall in-  
5 stitute prosecution hereunder,' so that said section as amend-  
6 ed shall read as follows:

'Sect. 13. All motor boats run or operated in any tidal  
2 or other waters within the state, shall be provided or

3 equipped with proper and suitable mufflers or other devices,  
4 which shall effectually deaden sound. Said mufflers shall  
5 be used all the time the engine of the motor boat is in opera-  
6 tion; provided that it shall be allowable to cut out said  
7 mufflers in case of boats while entered and competing in  
8 boat races held under the auspices of some regularly or-  
9 ganized club, between the hours of eight o'clock in the  
10 morning and sunset following. In addition to other reme-  
11 dies provided by statute, municipal officers, on complaint,  
12 shall institute prosecution hereunder.'
