RESOLVE, for Teacher's Pension for Annie L. Dunbar.

Resolved: That there be paid to Annie L. Dunbar of

- 2 Castine, Maine, Hancock county, a pension of four hun-
- 3 dred dollars per year, payable quarterly, from the fund
- 4 appropriated for teachers' pensions, beginning July first,
- 5 nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and continuing during
- 6 the remainder of her life.

She taught thirty-four years in the State of Maine. She is now sixty-two years of age and is in ill health, which prevents her from teaching any more.

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
