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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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RESOLVE, for Teacher's Pension for Annie L. Dunbar.

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Resolved: That there be paid to Annie L. Dunbar of  
2 Castine, Maine, Hancock county, a pension of four hun-  
3 dred dollars per year, payable quarterly, from the fund  
4 appropriated for teachers' pensions, beginning July first,  
5 nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and continuing during  
6 the remainder of her life.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

She taught thirty-four years in the State of Maine. She is now sixty-two years of age and is in ill health, which prevents her from teaching any more.
