IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to a State Entomologist.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The forest commissioner with the approval of
2 the governor and council shall appoint a trained entomol-
3 ogist to be known as the state entomologist, to hold office at
4 the pleasure of the forest commissioner.

Sect. 2. The duties of the state entomologist shall be to
2 answer calls for information on insect control and identifi-
3 cation, to supervise necessary control work not already pro-
4 vided for by law, and to assist other departments in work
5 along this line.
