# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Sixty of Chapter Fifty-seven of the Revised Statutes Relating to Number of Brakemen on Passenger Trains.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section sixty of chapter fifty-seven of the revised statutes

is hereby amended so that said section as amended shall read

as follows:

'Sect. 60. No train of passenger cars, moved by steam, 2 shall be run without at least one competent trainman. The 3 public utilities commission, on its own motion, or upon com-4 plaint, and after notice and hearing, may require the em5 ployment of such additional trainmen upon any train of 6 passenger cars as it shall determine to be necessary for its 7 safe operation.
