IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, for Pay and Expenses of Wardens of Sea and
Shore Fisheries.

Whereas, the funds appropriated by the legislature for the pay and expense of wardens of the sea and shore fisheries, are so nearly exhausted that additional funds will be absolutely essential to continue in service these wardens for the remaining months of the fiscal year to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and

Whereas, it is necessary for the proper enforcement of the laws relating to sea and shore fisheries that the wardens be continuously employed; and

Whereas, the aforesaid facts seem to this legislature to con-

stitute an emergency whereby the public peace, health and safety are endangered and emergency legislation is necessary to protect the welfare and credit of the state and conserve the various activities relating to the public peace, health and safety which are hereby involved;

Now, therefore, be it

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of eight thousand dollars to be expended for pay and expenses of the wardens required by the sea and shore fisheries commission for the proper enforcement of law.

In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
