RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Construction of a
New Motor Boat for Sea and Shore Fisheries.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of twenty thousand dollars for the construction of a
3 new motor boat for the sea and shore fisheries.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The boats now in use by the sea and shore fisheries commission are old, and unsafe for use in much of the work necessary to reasonably enforce the sea and shore fisheries laws and regulations. The commission at present have no boat of sufficient size and power to enable them to go off shore as is many times necessary in preventing lobster smacks and out-of-state boats from violating our laws.
