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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT Relating to Swimming or Bathing.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section ninety-eight of chapter four of the revised statutes  
2 as amended is hereby further amended by adding at the  
3 end thereof the following subsection:

‘XIV. For the regulation and prohibition of swimming  
2 or bathing in the waters of, in or bounding the municipality,  
3 and the regulation and prohibition of persons from appear-  
4 ing in any or all of the public streets and places clad in  
5 bathing robes or other costumes of a similar character.’
