STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Providing for the Purchase of "Music and Musicians of Maine."

Resolved: That two hundred copies of "Music and Musicians of Maine," by George Thornton Edwards, be purchased by the state at a price not exceeding five dollars per volume and not exceeding the retail price of the book. One copy shall be sent by the librarian of the Maine state library to each public library within the state, and one copy to each of the state normal schools, and the remaining copies shall be distributed at the discretion of the said librarian. The sum of one thousand dollars is hereby appropriated for this purpose.
