STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Hampden.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of thirteen thousand dollars, to aid in building a bridge
3 over York stream in the town of Hampden. The funds
4 for this purpose to be taken from the bridge maintenance
5 fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This bridge is to be constructed and maintained by the state.
It carries a great deal of traffic.
