STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, for the General Distribution of Data Concerning
the Resources of the State.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of seventy-five thousand dollars for the fiscal year from
3 July one, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, to June thirty,
4 nineteen hundred and thirty, and the sum of seventy-five
5 thousand dollars for the fiscal year from July one, nine-
6 teen hundred and thirty, to June thirty, nineteen hundred
7 and thirty-one, for the purpose of carrying out and con-
8 tinuing the provisions of chapter one hundred sixty-two of

9 the resolves of nineteen hundred twenty-seven, for the col-
10 lection, compilation, publication, general distribution and
11 advertising of data relative to the state, and the general
12 administration of the purposes of said chapter, same to be
13 expended by the Maine Development Commission, estab-
14 lished by said chapter.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Maine Development Commission was created by Chapter 162 of the Resolves of 1927 for the purpose of collecting, compiling and publishing data relative to the State. The Budget Committee after hearing the report of this commission recommends the appropriation of \$105,440 for each of the two succeeding fiscal years.
