IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Twenty of Chapter Thirty-four of the Revised Statutes Relative to State Stipends to Agricultural Societies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty of chapter thirty-four of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting before the words "evidence as to" in the fourth line of said section, the word 'satisfactory'; by inserting after the word "registration" in the fifth line thereof the word 'shall' and by striking out the word "satisfactory" in the fifth line thereof, so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 20. *Society offering premiums on grade males not*
2 *entitled to state aid.* No state stipend shall be paid to any
3 agricultural society offering or paying premiums on grade
4 males; the commissioner of agriculture may make this a
5 part of the sworn return to be made by the proper officers
6 of all agricultural societies, provided that satisfactory evi-
7 dence as to eligibility to registration shall be accepted as
8 proof of purity of blood.'
