IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Aid in the Enforcement of Statutes Governing  
the Use of Vehicles on Closed or Restricted Ways and  
Bridges.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The state highway commission may appoint any person  
2 then in its employ whose special duty it shall be to enforce  
3 the statutes and orders promulgated thereunder which pro-  
4 hibit or restrict the passage of vehicles and trailers over  
5 ways and bridges, or designate sections thereof, under such  
6 conditions, or in such manner, as may cause undue damage  
7 to any such way or bridge. Every such person shall be

8 appointed in writing by the commission to serve during its  
9 pleasure, and shall have the same power as sheriffs and  
10 their deputies to arrest and prosecute all violators within  
11 the territorial limits designated in his appointment. He  
12 shall be entitled to the same fees as sheriffs and their depu-  
13 ties for like services.
