### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, for Teacher's Pension for Sadie Cummings.

Resolved: That there be paid to Sadie Cummings of 2 Waldo, a pension of four hundred dollars per year, pay-3 able quarterly, from the fund appropriated for teachers' 4 pensions, beginning July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-5 nine, and continuing during the remainder of her life.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

She taught thirty-eight years in the state of Maine. She is now fifty-nine years of age, and is in ill health which prevents her from teaching any more.
