# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

- AN ACT to Amend Section Six of Chapter Eighty-three of the Revised Statutes, Relative to Clerk of County Commissioners.
- Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
  Section six of chapter eighty-three of the revised statutes
  2 is hereby amended by striking out the whole of said section
  3 and by substituting in place thereof the following:

'Sect. 6. Clerk of courts and deputy clerk of courts to be 2 clerk and deputy clerk of commissioners. The clerk of the 3 judicial courts in each county is clerk of the county com-4 missioners; and in counties having a deputy clerk such 5 deputy or deputies shall be deputy clerk of the commis-

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6 sioners and in the absence of the clerk have the same powers 7 and duties. The clerk and deputy clerk or clerks of the 8 county commissioners shall be known as the county clerk 9 and deputy county clerk. When clerk and his deputies are 10 in attendance at other courts, the clerk may appoint a clerk 11 pro tempore to the commissioners for whose doings he is 12 responsible. Such clerk shall be sworn and make a daily 13 record of their doings, and they shall examine it, and when 14 correct certify it and it shall be copied into their records 15 by the stated clerk.'

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
