AN ACT Relating to the Increase of the Salary of the Assistant County Attorney for the County of Androscoggin.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter two hundred and six of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-five, is hereby amended, by striking out in the eleventh line of said chapter, the words "eight hundred dollars" and inserting in place thereof the words 'one thousand dollars,' so that said chapter as amended shall read as follows:

'Provisions for assistant county attorney of Androscoggin county; duties, salary, term of office. The county attorney of the county of Androscoggin may appoint an assistant,

4 to be approved by the justice of the superior court for said  
5 county. Said assistant shall take the oath prescribed for  
6 county attorneys, and assist the county attorney in the ordi-  
7 nary duties of his office in the drawing of indictments, in  
8 the hearing of complaints before the grand jury, and in the  
9 preparation and trial of criminal cases. He shall, when  
10 directed by the county attorney, act as counsel for the state  
11 in the trial of complaints, before judges of municipal and  
12 police courts and trial justices. Said assistant county at-  
13 torney shall receive an annual salary of one thousand dol-  
14 lars payable from the state treasury in monthly payments  
15 on the last day of each month. The assistant county attor-  
16 ney shall hold his office during the term of the county  
17 attorney by whom he was appointed, subject to removal  
18 at any time by the justice of the superior court for said  
19 county.'

Sect. 2. The provisions of this act shall date back to Jan-  
2 uary first, nineteen hundred twenty-nine, so that the increase  
3 of salary herein provided shall take effect as of that date.
