# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Expenses of the Electoral College for the State of Maine for the Year Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-nine.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of two hundred and seventy-one dollars to defray the 3 expenses of the electoral college for the state of Maine 4 which convened at Augusta on the second day of January, 5 nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

This resolve as indicated in the text covers the mileage per diem, clerical help and miscellaneous expenses of the Electoral College.
