Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for services and thirty-3 one dollars (\$31.00) for mileage, to be paid Philip T. Car-4 roll, of Southwest Harbor, for services as assistant folder 5 at the organization of the eighty-fourth legislature.
