**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE**

, RESOLVE, in Favor of the Augusta State Hospital.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for
2 the Augusta State Hospital the sum of ten thousand dol-
3 lars to be used for the purposes of dredging the Kennebec
4 river near the dock belonging to the state hospital, and for
5 repairs on the dock and its appurtenances.
