STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Provide for the Completion of the Payment of
a Bonus to Maine Soldiers and Sailors in the War with
Spain.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The governor, with the advice and consent of
2 the council, is hereby authorized and directed to issue from
3 time to time as may be necessary, under the provisions of
4 this act, short term interest bearing serial notes of indebt-
5 edness for the purpose of completing payment of a bonus
6 to the soldiers and sailors of the state of Maine in the war

7 with Spain, provided, however, that any indebtedness so
8 incurred shall not exceed two hundred thousand dollars
9 and shall be subject to the provisions of article forty-two
10 of the constitution of Maine.

Sect. 2. Each honorably discharged soldier and sailor,
2 or member of the armed forces, resident of the state of
3 Maine, who served in the quota of Maine, in the war with
4 Spain, shall be paid one hundred dollars bonus; provided,
5 however, that any person having received any portion of
6 said bonus shall receive only such unpaid balance as may
7 be due him.

Sect. 3. The adjutant general is hereby authorized and
2 directed to determine the validity of the claims filed with
3 his department for said bonuses. The claims so approved
4 by him shall be forwarded to the state auditor who shall
5 certify the same for payments to the governor and council.
