STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Providing for Moving Pictures of Maine's Wild Life for Recreational Advertising Purposes.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of twenty-five hundred dollars for the fiscal year from 3 July one, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, to June thirty, 4 nineteen hundred and thirty, and the sum of twenty-five 5 hundred dollars for the fiscal year from July one, nineteen 6 hundred and thirty, to June thirty, nineteen hundred and 7 thirty-one, for the purpose of advertising the different 8 phases of the wild life of Maine by the method of motion 9 pictures and that said sum be taken from funds in the

treasury not otherwise appropriated; two thousand dollars of said sum to be expended under the direction of the department of inland fisheries and game, each fiscal year, of the purpose of collecting and making of motion pictures of Maine's wild life, and that five hundred dollars of said sum be expended, each fiscal year, by the Maine development commission for the purpose of distribution, transportation, and advertising of said motion pictures.
