STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Lyman.

Resolved: That the sum of three thousand fifty-four
2 dollars and twenty-five cents which was set apart and appro-
3 priated by the state as its portion of the amount required
4 for the construction of a state aid highway in the town of
5 Lyman and now in the state treasury, be and the same is
6 hereby appropriated to the town of Lyman to aid in the
7 repair of the road leading from Waterboro to South Hollis
8 in Hollis.
