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RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Study and Control  
of the Birch Saw-Fly Leaf Miner and Birch Case Bearer.

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PREAMBLE

Whereas, white birch is one of the chief sources of wealth of the state, and the protection of same from insects is of the greatest importance; to this end it is a paramount duty of this legislature to have funds provided without delay for such protection. Delay in the providing of such funds would expose the white birch to danger of destruction by the birch saw-fly

leaf miner and birch case bearer, preventable by adequate precautions, now therefore be it resolved :

Section 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated the  
2 sum of eight thousand dollars for each of the fiscal years  
3 nineteen hundred and thirty and nineteen hundred and  
4 thirty-one for the study and control of the birch saw-fly  
5 leaf miner and birch case bearer, to be expended under the  
6 direction of the forest commissioner.

Sect. 2. In view of the emergency expressed in the pre-  
2 amble hereof, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
