STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Charles Brown
of Liberty.

Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be,
2 and hereby is, granted to Charles Brown, of Liberty, to be
3 paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and
4 sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July
5 first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and continue until
6 otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Charles Brown is the son of an honorably discharged veteran of the Civil War. He is over seventy years of age and is helpless.
