IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Thirty-one of Chapter One Hundred and Seventeen of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Salaries of Public Officers, and the Compensation of Members of the Government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-one of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by striking out said section in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following:

"The annual salary of the chairman of the public utilities

2 commission shall be six thousand dollars, and the salary
3 of each of the other members shall be five thousand dollars
4 per annum. The salary of subordinate officials and em-
5 ployees of said commission shall be left to the discretion
6 of the public utilities commission, subject to approval of the
7 governor and council; the commissioners and all employees
8 shall receive actual expenses when traveling on official busi-
9 ness.'
